We continued with our unit on the Romans. We started by asking our own perceptive questions relating to our learning, thinking about what we might want to find out about the Romans.

We then moved onto looking at chronological order and ordered some events that happened in the Roman time.

Science

In Science, we continued our topic on Rocks, starting with a quiz, recapping our learning from last week.

We then went back to our table from last week, and carried out some experiments relating to the hardness of rocks, by scratching them with a nail, and whether they react to acid, by pouring vinegar on them.

English

We wrote with adjectives, adverbs and in the past tense. We also put paragraphs into our diary, to split it up.
