Science

In Science, we continued our topic on Rocks, looking at soils this week, comparing soils and looking at how they were formed.

We carried out an experiment, looking at the drainage rate for different soils, pouring water into a container with the soils in and seeing how much water drained through the soil.

English

This week, we looked at the book 'So you think you've got it bad? A kids life in Ancient Rome.' We wrote a non-chronological report on Roman life, using the book and iPads to support our research. We had a question in our introduction and included subordinating conjunctions in our writing.
