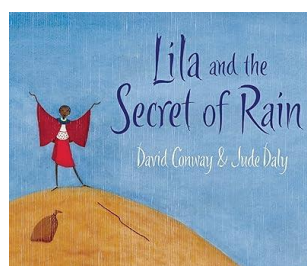
We named some of our body parts.
