We discussed how we are all unique.

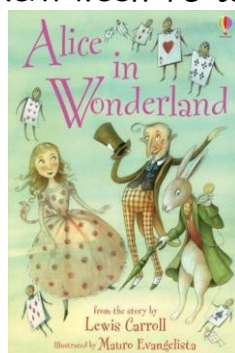
