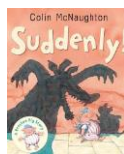

RE - Creation and Covenant

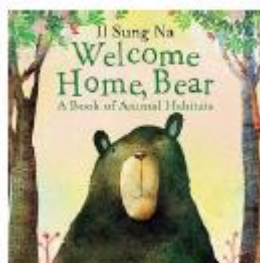
This week we learnt to retell the story of Noah and the flood by working collaboratively on a storyboard. We have learnt what a covenant is and thought about how we can look after God's creation.
