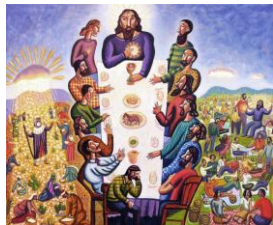

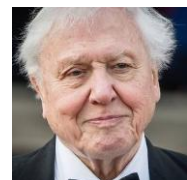
In PE this week we have improved our bouncing and catching skills. We have also developed our jumping skills.
