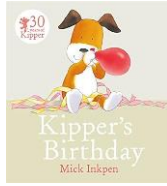


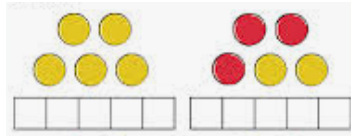
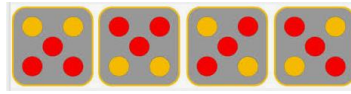
Literacy
