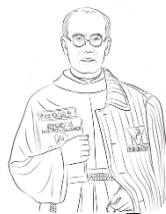
This week, we continued to put our netball skills to the test. The children worked hard to practise passing, catching and footwork, showing determination as they developed their coordination skills.
