## PE

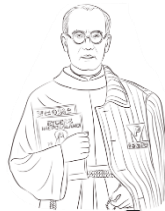
In PE, we tested our netball skills by playing bench ball, practising catching and defending. Well done to **Team B** for great teamwork!

## RE

This week we read and discussed Matthew 11, where John the Baptist sends his followers to ask Jesus if he is the one who has been sent by God. We acted out a role play showing how Jesus replied to

John's followers. We then discussed Jesus' miracles and how they show that he is a Servant Messiah. We also discussed the comparison between Jesus and the prophet Isaiah, who preached the good news in the Old Testament. This showed how Jesus fulfilled the prophecies Isaiah spoke about.

After this, we created artwork to describe one of Jesus' miracles and explain its spiritual meaning. For example, when Jesus heals the blind, it shows that he helps people to see God's truth.

## Science

This week, we have continued our topic on **Materials**. We investigated the properties of liquids and gases. We explored what happens when liquids are poured, including how they flow and change shape to fit their container.

We also investigated whether liquids and gases can be compressed and how gases spread out to fill the space they are in.

Through these investigations, we learned how liquids and gases behave differently from solids.
