Dear Y3 & 4 Parents,

Year 3 and Year 4 Easter Play

As previously advised, this year's Year 3 and Year 4 Easter Play will be on Tuesday 24th March 2026. Performances will be held in our school hall and a ticket system will be in place to ensure that numbers are kept in-line with our Risk Assessment and Fire Regulations.

In preparation of this year's Easter Play, please can your child bring the following items of clothing to school, in a named carrier bag:-

- Black plain long sleeved t-shirt/top
- Black joggers or leggings
- Black shoes or trainers

Four tickets (2 tickets per performance) will be given to each child next Friday (20th March). Should you not need all of your allocated tickets, I am happy for you to give them to another family, as long as every attendee has a ticket on arrival.

- 2.00pm - Younger siblings are allowed to attend this performance, but a ticket will be required (even if sitting on you lap), as we are limited to numbers attending as stated above.
- 6.00 pm - Please note that all siblings in school will have seen the play in the afternoon. I ask any children under the age of 5 attend the afternoon performance.

In the evening, we ask that children arrive back at school for 5.30pm to allow for costume change. Can children please enter school through the Holly Walk Gates then via the school office. Parents must enter school for the evening performance via the Wraparound Care Club entrance, and tickets must be presented at the door. At the end of the performances, the children will be dismissed into the hall.

Photographs will be available to purchase at the performance £2 each (cash), and donations from the performance will be split between Catholic Children's Society and the St Cross School Building Fund.
