COSTUME IDEAS FOR WORLD BOOK DAY

Alice: Blue dress (can even be school summer dress), white apron (or make one from an old pillowcase), black headband, white tights, black school shoes, safety-pin a paper label saying "DRINK ME", carry a small toy rabbit, print and pin a playing card to the apron.
