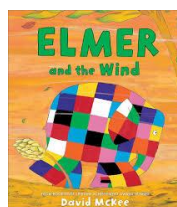

We have used textured materials to create rubbings.

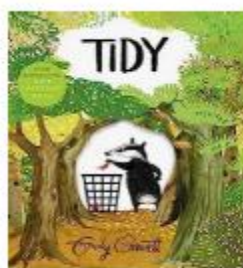
RE - Creation and Covenant
